



Punishment Provisions

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or off campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

- 1. Debarring from appearing in any sessional test/ university examination or withholding results
- 2. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- 3. Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits
- 4. Suspension from the college for a period of one month
- 5. Cancellation of admission
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc
- 7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- 8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period
- 9. Dismissal from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution
- 10. Fine up to twenty-five thousand rupees
- 11. Imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both
- 12. Collective punishment When the students committing or aiding the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.





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Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited both within the College premises or any other part of the college as well as on public transport. The directives of the University Grants Commission, its Acts, Ordinances and the Guidance of the relevant orders of the Honourable Supreme Court of India (Civil Appeal No. 887 of 2009 dated 8.5.2009) will be strictly adhered to, in all matters related to ragging. Therefore, no act of ragging, major or minor, shall go unnoticed. No ragger, male or female, student or non-student, shall go unpunished.

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




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




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




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Anti-Ragging Committee Meeting





The meeting commenced with a welcome note by Chairman Air Marshal (Dr.) Ajit S. Bhonsle to all the committee members. The Chairman greeted all the participants attending the Online Meeting. He urged that the online mode should not dilute the importance of the deliberations and therefore undivided attention from 11 am to 1 pm is necessary. On behalf of the Members, he welcomed Dr. Sunita Siwach, who has taken charge as Joint Secretary (Anti-Ragging Cell) with effect from 07.03.2024. He also bid farewell to the former JS (ARC), Col. Vipin Kaushal, SM and he appreciated and put on record Col. Kaushal's contribution to the cause of anti-ragging measures. In welcoming Dr. Sunita Siwach, the Chairman expressed that she has a brilliant academic record and vast experience in educational administration and was involved with Anti-ragging aspects in the past also, and hoped that with her experience and expertise the Anti-Ragging Campaign will see renewed direction and vigour. Speaking about the renewed direction and vigour in the Anti-Ragging Campaign or the Mission on which all of us are engaged in, we need to seriously introspect and deliberate whether the measures of Anti-Ragging are effective and positive result is visible on the ground across the Educational Institutions in our country. Many a Guidelines, Regulations and Mechanisms are in place emanating from slew of Hon'ble Supreme Court's Orders; however, the question still lingers as to do we have our fingers on the pulse of what is

happening in and outside the educational campuses today? Are the students and parents made convincingly aware of the prevention and prohibition of ragging and do they have faith and trust that their grievances would be adequately addressed, without further recrimination or victimization? Are the potential perpetrators of ragging aware of the consequences of ragging? Are the Heads of the University/ College/ Institutions themselves on a war- footing to fight the menace of ragging on their campuses?

Or, are we fooling ourselves with mechanistic fulfilment of paper work and unreal statistical feedbacks which are diverse from the ground realities? Is our analysis at the UGC ARC Call Centre and the C4Y useful to adopt pro-active approach and out-of-the-box, innovative measures, which translates the theoretical output to effective solutions on ground?

The Chairman alluded to the cases of suicides in the Jadavpur University, Kolkata (09.08.2023) and Kerala Veterinary University (18.02.2024). In the latter case, it was appreciated that ARC at UGC was prompt to inform and follow up on the matter. In this case, the Hon'ble Governor Kerala has taken swift actions. This highlights the effective and expeditious role of Hon'ble Governors of States/ UTs who are Chancellors of their respective State Universities and the need to engage with the office of the Hon'ble Governors on matters of Anti-ragging measures under their State/ UT.

The Chairman stressed that this forum is meant for discussing issues threadbare. It is not merely for showing as to how many boxes have been ticked and are the HEIs under your Councils complying with Regulations of UGC and various Councils. It is a forum to discuss matters beyond the "Feel-good" factors on the paper; the harsh realities, practical difficulties, setbacks as also the innovative and technological solutions including use of electronic social media platforms/ Apps.

We need to go on an "offensive" and not "Defensive" against the scourge of Ragging and not be "defensive". We need to get out of our comfort zones and deliver what is expected out of us. Today's deliberations would lead us in that direction.

Chairman requested JS (ARC) to take the agenda and JS (ARC) welcomed the Chairman and all the members of the committee and took up the agenda for discussion.

Item No.1 Confirmation of Minutes of 22nd meeting of the Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee to prevent ragging in Higher Educational Institutions held on 19.01.2024.

The minutes of the 22nd meeting were confirmed by the Committee.

Item No.2 Action Taken on the minutes of the last meeting by UGC and Regulatory Bodies.

The Action Taken on the part of UGC was informed by JS (ARC) to the Committee and committee appreciated the efforts of UGC.

Item No.3 Report, Analysis and Remedies/Modalities for the institutions for non-compliance of UGC Regulations for curbing the menace of Ragging in HEIs – 2009, a presentation by Anti-Ragging Monitoring Agency.

The Monitoring Agency informed the committee about the number of ragging complaints and its redressal till the level of victim's/ complainant satisfaction and monitoring agencies have suggested following remedies/modalities to the committee:

- UGC will communicate with all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) regarding compliance with UGC regulations 2009, particularly focusing on compliances info on the anti-ragging portal.
- ii. A specific annual time frame to be established for HEIs to submit compliance information, with a deadline set for June 30th each year.
- iii. UGC will issue special reminders to HEIs that have not yet submitted their compliances as per the UGC 2009 regulations on the anti-ragging portal.
- iv. Consequences or penalties to be imposed for HEIs failing to implement and submit their compliances within the specified timeframe.
- v. The councils will facilitate their respective universities and colleges in completing the online submission of compliances.
- vi. Councils to verify compliance information of their respective HEIs according to the new format on the anti-ragging portal.
- vii. UGC will send strict notices to all HEIs to update their institution's Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad contact details on their official websites.
- viii. HEIs to support the monitoring agency, C4Y, in reducing ragging incidents in colleges and universities.

Item No.4 Report by 24x7 Anti Ragging Helpline of UGC on the modalities for dealing ragging complaints and difficulties faced while handling ragging complaints.

Shri Deepak Goyal, Managing Director, Anti Ragging Helpline demonstrated the working flowchart of Anti Ragging Helpline from registering complaints to its closure. He also informed about other tasks performed in Anti Ragging Helpline other than complaints like focusing on affidavits and compliance.

Item No.5 Presentation by NMC, AICTE and any other regulatory bodies for steps taken for implementation of compliance of UGC Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging – 2009, if any.

The National Medical Commission gave presentation in the meeting. Dr. Arvind Kumar, representing the National Medical Commission, provided an update on the progress made towards complying with UGC Regulations. He emphasized the establishment of a National Task Force by the Commission's Anti-Ragging Committee to tackle the pressing issues of mental health and suicides among medical students in India. This Task Force aims to conduct a thorough study spanning from 2018 to 2022, focusing on

mental health and suicide trends among medical students.

To facilitate this study, the Task Force will administer a comprehensive survey questionnaire tailored for Undergraduate and Postgraduate medical students, as well as Faculty and Administrative staff. This questionnaire is designed to pinpoint areas where support can be enhanced to foster a healthier learning environment. Sections of the questionnaire will delve into demographics, academic stressors, social support, coping mechanisms, clinical workload, and administrative challenges etc.

The National Task Force is committed to submitting its final report by May 31, 2024, outlining its findings and proposing strategies to promote mental well-being and prevent suicides among medical students across the country.

Item No. 6 Discussion on Funds for media campaign/orientation programme for wide publicity of Anti Ragging Prevention Program at PAN India Level.

JS (ARC) informed the committee that funds requirement to the media campaign has been sent to Ministry of Education and waiting for their positive response. Chairman of the committee asked Sh. B.K. Singh, Director (HE) in this regard. Director (HE) apprised the Committee that the UGC has not settled the account of previous releases and outstanding balances needs to be returned to Gol along with interest as per provisions of GFR, 2017.

Item No. 7 Points by JS (ARC), UGC.

JS (ARC) apprised action taken by UGC for curbing the menace of ragging and in this regard, she informed committee that advisories to all HEIs are being sent as a part of Action Taken of National Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee held on 19.01.2024, with following recommendations:

- Taking Anti Ragging Measures
- Conducting workshops, Orientation Programmes
- Appointing Psychologists/Counsellors
- Increasing CCTV Surveillance
- Include Police Authorities while dealing with complaints.
- Directing to provide the contact details of ARC & ARS on the website, especially the ragging prone colleges.

JS (ARC) suggested to write CBSE, JS (School Education, MoE), School Board of Education to organize Anti Ragging awareness programmes at School Levels particularly senior Secondary level so that students at school be aware about the anti-ragging mechanisms available at HEI's. She also suggested collaborating with UNESCO, which is already working to prevent bullying in schools.

Item No.8 Submission by Secretary, UGC.

Secretary, UGC assured the committee that all directions will be immediately implemented.

Submission by Prof. Santanu Mishra:

Prof. Santanu Misra from IIT Kanpur suggested selecting a few medical schools and developing them as exemplars of ragging and harassment-free campuses. He recommended seeking expert opinion and support to shape these model schools and proposed setting clear task-specific milestones along with timelines for this initiative. The successful methods and practices established in these model schools could then be shared with all other medical schools across the country to help them become free from ragging too. It is important to choose these model medical schools from different parts of the country so that the impact is felt everywhere.

Submission by Sh. Varadan Chandar:

Shri Varadan Chandar conveyed the need for shifting all our Anti Ragging Actions from the present "reactive, controlling" mode to "proactive, positive" mode.

He agreed that concrete plans for creating a different system of students' interpersonal relationships like the 'buddy culture' like in the armed forces or 'Mentor-Mentee' type of bonding needs to be generated. The eventual positive outcome expected to the society out of such healthy interpersonal relationships and mutually caring support systems built up amongst the student community can be enormous, he emphasized.

Generation of a guideline's brochure to the heads of institutions with the inputs of experts from us on these lines can be the first step in this direction, he felt.

Introduction of such novel plans could further be considered at the school levels itself as an extended part of the National Education Policy and such initiatives could go a long way in curbing the practices of 'bullying' prevalent at such levels, nipping such undesirable attitudes at the bud itself.

To address the problems of increasing number ragging related suicides, he reiterated that deviation from the current advisory roles by the regulatory bodies and adopting an approach of 'carrot and stick' policy towards their constituent institutions.

While severely admonishing and reprimanding those institutions where these incidents are getting alarmingly recurrent, it is equally important for the regulatory bodies to identify and proudly appreciate and reward those institutions under them who have been consistently maintaining a "Ragging Free" atmosphere in their Campuses at least for the last ten consecutive years. He felt that the impact created by inspirational motivation of such dual approach policy over others could be very significant especially if such award functions are carried out with sound imagination and great fanfare and publicity

inviting popular dignitaries and encouraging nationwide media coverage for such events.

He further conveyed an earnest wish that to begin with, the Task Force of NMC itself could give consideration for such a modified policy approach on an experimental basis.

Regarding response actions for the complaint communications to our call center, he emphasized on the need for distinguishing and culling out the small numbers of serious and emergency types of complaints from out of the vast numbers of the run of the mill types of complaints and identifying them for closer and intense empathetic actions.

For prevention of any potential untoward consequences in such complaints, a close scrutiny of the past data has to be carried out to identify screaming words and terms, emotive words of despair or desperation, panicked words of vulnerability etc. which point towards the seriousness of the situation at the field levels.

When these terms are captured in the current times, they have to be flagged as RED cases and must be handled with sensitivity by senior and experienced staff only. Closely communicating with the students with great empathy and simultaneously alerting the authorities promptly in such instances for controlling actions should be carried out with a firefighting mode without any laxity.

Handling such cases with great alacrity and vigil and preventing all possible suicides with such prompt responsive actions can be the greatest act of joy and fulfillment for the staff of our call centers. This Committee will be very glad to hear such success stories from their Chief in their subsequent presentations.

Submission by Ajay Kumar Joshi, US (ARC)

US (ARC) suggested that it would not be appropriate not to mention the "Seat Leaving Bond" (of around Rs.30-40 lakh) heard during the representation of the National Medical Commission.

It is a huge penalty if any student at any stage evaluates himself correctly whether to continue or discontinue his study. Such a penalty could lead to a mishappening. This is PENALTY for TRUTH.

Closing Remarks by Air Marshal (Dr.) Ajit S. Bhonsle:

In his closing remarks, the Chairman pointed out that the Hon'ble Supreme Court had been seized with the issue of Ragging since 1998. Between 2001-2009, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has passed eight Judgements/ Interim Orders/ Orders; the first one was passed in 04 May 2001 and the last one on 16 May 2009. Across these pronouncements, the Hon'ble Apex Court has also delved on the Ragging / Bullying in our Schools and the need to address the menace from School level itself. This is an important issue which needs to be attended to, as students graduate from Schools to

Higher Educational Institutes and therefore, they need to be indoctrinated at the school-level itself about the scourge of Ragging / Bullying. This will bring a cultural change across our educational institutes from Primary / Secondary / Higher Secondary / College / University. The Draft Regulations/Guidelines for curbing Ragging in Schools was prepared by UGC and forwarded to Ministry of Education on 13 July 2022. The same may be processed on priority for issue to all the School Education Control bodies and State Governments.

The Chairman suggested that there should be a web-link provided on the website of Ministry of Education to the ARC (UGC) web portal. It was so in past, when the website of the Ministry of HRD had a web – link with the Anti Ragging Committee's Portal. Further the ARC (UGC) web page needs to be dynamic and interactive. Necessary investment in e- infrastructure needs to be done. He also recommended that the subject of Anti-Ragging Measures be included in the agenda points at the Meeting of the State Govt Education Ministers Meeting in Delhi under the aegis of the Ministry of Education, Govt of India. Further, in the forms of the UGC's plan funding meetings/ visits to the HEIs / UNIVs, the aspect of Anti-ragging Measures be discussed.

He urged that the Anti- Ragging App be made operational expeditiously for which necessary funds be released.

In the upcoming revision of the 'UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational institutions, 2009', it is recommended that in the aspects of "What constitutes Ragging?" the aspects of malicious use of electronic media / mobile technology such as Cyber -bullying, Stalking, Sextortion, Doxing, to harass individuals or to cause harm to another, may be included. The after effects of which are severe leading the victim to shame, guilt, isolation, humiliation, depression, anxiety and suicidal tendencies. The HEIs need to be cognizant of it and have mechanisms to report and act upon such cases. The next off line Meeting will be in June 24 at the UGC, for which the date will be decided by end of May 24.

The Chairman thanked all the participants and closed the meeting.

The meeting concluded with JS (ARC) proposing the vote of thanks to all the members attending this meeting.


